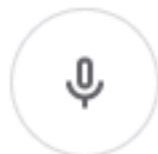




When in Google Meet you can present your screen or an application that you want to show your audience

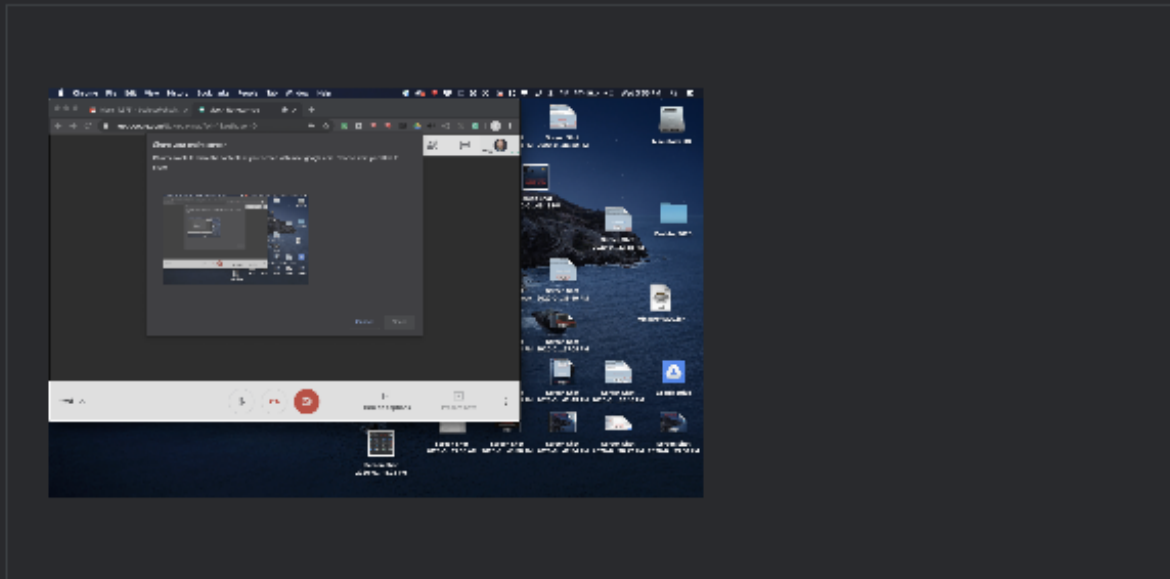


If you want to share just a window you would click on "A window". A window actually refers to an application
